ELDER BELDER	Grape Variety	Scheurebe , the "daughter of Riesling", more aromatic and playful than Riesling - just as classy.
	Vineyard site	Großkarlbacher Burgweg, gentle slope facing south
	Soil	Limestone , good buffer for high acidity grapes. The main soil of many great wine regions.
	Classification	Kabinett (light, non-chaptalized)
	Vintage	2013 - late vegetation period, crisp and fresh wines with moderate alcohol content.
	Style	light, refreshing wine with airy fruity citrus aromas; balanced touch of sweetness. Crisp acidity and low in alcohol content - really easy to enjoy as an every day treat.
	History	The Lingenfelder family has winemaking expe- rience since 13 generations. The first records date back to 1520.
	Vineyard	Sustainable viticulture is practiced out of respect for the land, so that the next 13 generations should get a chance to live off the land as well; without herbicides, without irrigation, only minimal fertilization and lots of biodiversity.
Beutscher Pfaßkansen LDP:	Cellar	Winemaking goes beyond organic: no yeast culture addition, no fining, minimal fil- tering and no chaptalization in premium wines like this one – in one word: hands off.
