Grape Variety

Scheurebe, the “daughter of Riesling”, more aromatic and playful than Riesling - just as classy.

Vineyard site

Freinsheimer Musikantenbuckel, gentle slope facing south

Soil

Sandy, which in agricultural terms is considered poor, but is great to enhance fruit flavor in premium viticulture.

Classification

Kabinett (light, non-chaptalized)

Vintage

2015 - very warm year with ripe fruits giving a full aromatic flavour to the wine.

Style

dry, refreshing wine with airy fruity citrus aromas. Great structure and a slight grapefruit tang on the palate are the hallmark of our Scheurebe.

History

The Lingenfelder family has winemaking experience since **13 generations**. The first records date back to 1520.

Vineyard

Sustainable viticulture is practiced out of respect for the land, so that the next 13 generations should get a chance to live off the land as well; without herbicides, without irrigation, only minimal fertilization and lots of biodiversity.

Cellar

Winemaking goes beyond organic: **no yeast culture addition, no fining, minimal filtering** and no chaptalization in premium wines like this one – in one word: hands off.

Residual Sugar: 4 g/l

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
