Vineyard site

Freinsheimer Musikantenbuckel, gentle slope facing south

Soil

**Sandy**, which in agricultural terms is considered poor, but is great to enhance fruit flavor in premium viticulture.

Classification

**Kabinett** (light, non-chaptalized)

**Vintage** 

**2015** - very warm year with ripe fruits giving a full aromatic flavour to the wine.

Style

**dry, refreshing** wine with airy fruity citrus aromas. Great structure and a slight grapefruit tang on the palate are the hallmark of our Scheurebe.

History

The Lingenfelder family has winemaking experience since **13 generations**. The first records date back to 1520.

Vineyard

**Sustainable viticulture** is practiced out of respect for the land, so that the next 13 generations should get a chance to live off the land as well; without herbicides, without irrigation, only minimal fertilization and lots of biodiversity.

Cellar

Winemaking goes beyond organic: **no yeast culture addition, no fining, minimal filtering** and no chaptalization in premium wines like this one – in one word: hands off.
