## LINGENFELDER ESTATE



<b>Grape Variety</b>	<b>Spätburgunder</b> , the German Pinot Noir
<b>Vineyard site</b>	<b>Großkarlbacher Burgweg</b> , gentle slope facing south
<b>Soil</b>	<b>Limestone</b> , good buffer for high acidity grapes
<b>Classification</b>	<b>Spätlese</b> (rich, non-chaptalized)
<b>Vintage</b>	<b>2013</b> - late vegetation period, crisp and fresh wines with moderate alcohol content.
<b>Style</b>	<b>dry, elegant</b> with a warm burgundy color. Attractive combination of strawberry and fresh hazelnut aromas followed by a cinnamon spice. Matured in used german barrique for 24 month. Well integrated, fruit supportive, oak background flavors.
<b>History</b>	The Lingenfelder family has winemaking experience since <b>13 generations</b> . The first records date back to 1520.
<b>Vineyard</b>	<b>Sustainable viticulture</b> is practiced out of respect for the land, so that the next 13 generations should get a chance to live off the land as well; without herbicides, without irrigation, only minimal fertilization and lots of biodiversity.
<b>Cellar</b>	Winemaking goes beyond organic: <b>no yeast culture addition, no fining, minimal filtering</b> and no chaptalization in premium wines like this one – in one word: hands off.

ABV: 13.5 %

Acidity: 5 g/l

Residual Sugar: 0 g/l

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
