	Vintage	2013 - late vegetation period, crisp and fresh wines with moderate alcohol content.
	Style	dry, elegant with a warm burgundy color. Attractive combination of strawberry and fresh hazelnut aromas followed by a cinnamon spice. Matured in used german barrique for 24 month. Well integrated, fruit supportive, oak background flavors.
INGENFELDER	History	The Lingenfelder family has winemaking experience since 13 generations . The first records date back to 1520.

	Cellar	Winemaking goes beyond organic: no yeast culture addition, no fining, minimal fil- tering and no chaptalization in premium wines like this one – in one word: hands off.
