Origin:

The Pfalz, also known as Palatinate, is an ancient, almost 2000 years old, viticultural area situated on the left bank of the Rhine River in the south west corner of Germany. It is one of the sunniest and driest regions in Germany, but is still considered a cool climate setting for viticulture.

Style:

The Lingenfelder bee-label Morio-Muscat is a **sweet**, **lean** wine with an aromatic taste. Hints of nutmeg an citrus flavours are present. It works very well with spicey asian foods or as a desert wine that is not too sweet.
